Long Island City Artists, inc., was founded in 1986 by an artist, Margret Dreikausen. It had headquarters until 2008 on the 3rd floor of the Romo Paper Factory, now The Paper Factory Hotel. All the artists had to relocate their studios, and LIC-A is currently operating the Plaxall Gallery, 5-25 46th Avenue, LIC 11101, where it has been temporarily headquartered since Fall 2016.

LIC-A's programs include monthly exhibitions of visual art primarily by Queens artists, and performances, workshops, and musical events open and free to the public. A documentary "Making Connections: Artists Working in Queens" is in production and will be shown on QPTV and Youtube later this Fall. LIC-A is currently raising funds for its goal of a permanent space for its community-related and expanding program.
