## Mary Miss: Landscape in Photo/Drawings

Senior & Shopmaker, New York, Architectural apparitions emerge from a proliferation of photographs in these large, precise collages from a series Miss began in 1990. Grafting together multiple views of individual derelict industrial or agricultural structurescollapsing piers, irrigation systems, and the like-Miss, far from concealing her method, celebrates its seams. While cubism and Matta-Clark's interiors cannot be far from her mind, the ten works here deal explicitly with site, and, as in her large-scale environmental pieces, the artist's private reverie takes on a public dimension.
