(Un)Common Light is a showcase of noted New York-based female abstract painters: Elisabeth Condon and Carole d'Inverno. Both are former Artists in Residence at A&H. Condon's paintings are an intersection of nature, décor, and abstraction. d'Inverno's work translates historical and geographical data from local communities into humanized abstractions. The dialogue in this exhibition will explore light; the formal aspects of color, line, and shape; as well as memory and collective history.

A&H's 2023 season, (Un)Common Conversations, explores the interplay between place, time, and personal history. The result is a series of 5 exhibitions that establish a dialogue between culturally diverse artists working in similar mediums.
